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

Latin America: A protected market opening up to the EU

- Mexico is an old agreement which parties are considering a review. Potatoes is one of the sectors that could gain the most from a review of trade concessions.
- Chile was the second agreement in the region and duty-free access to EU exporters contributed to strong growth
- Recent agreements with Colombia, Peru are fully dismantling tariff duties on potatoes. Central America will liberalise fry potatoes.
- July's 2014 deal with **Ecuador** will pave the way for liberalisation within 10 (fry potatoes) to 15 y(ware potatoes)
- Negotiations with Mercosur: potatoes important EU offensive interest, as Brazil constitutes single most important market after Russia; process evolving slowly.

Africa: world's fastest growing market opens up (partially) to EU potato exports

- Northern Africa is key outlay for EU exports, with countries such as Egypt and Morocco providing preferential access to EU exporters
- West Africa EPA will provide liberalisation of seeds potatoes five years after the entry into force (expected 2016)
- TDCA (2000) offered duty-free access to **South Africa** market. **EPA SADC** will enlarge these conditions to other Southern Africa countries. **But**: safeguards until 2016
- EPA SADC timing: negotiations concluded in July 2014. Expected entry into force 2016.



Africa trade: Northern Africa is the main market for EU seed potatoes; West Africa relevant for ware potatoes, despite high import duties

Southeast Asia: Active trade agenda can unlock potential of a market with high price

- Duties remain the major obstacle to EU exports to
 Thailand and India, for all potatoes types, and an important economic hurdle impeding higher exports to Japan and Vietnam of fry potatoes.
- **EU-Vietnam** talks progressing towards end game, with negotiations expected to be concluded in forthcoming months. Potatoes not a sensitive product for Vietnam.
- **EU-Japan** negotiations in intermediate step. Still no conclusion in view, agriculture remains key stumbling block
- **India**'s new government not yet prepared to resume talks. As the world's third largest potato producer, the country follows a very defensive stance.
- FTA talks with **Thailand** currently on hold, after coup

Europe: Mixed winds ahead

- 6th August's **Russian ban** initially stopped all fresh and uncooked frozen potatoes. But as of 20th August seed potatoes have been authorised.
- Russia is traditionally the main partner for ware potatoes (banned). However trade had been declining in face of SPS measures that had been adopted prior to establishing sanctions.
- **Ukraine's DCFTA** enters into force on 1 November 2014, pending UKR Parliament ratification next week (15th Sep).
- Most potato trade will be liberalised within 3 years. Sliced fry potatoes would be subkect to partial liberalisation.

North America: large producer and main competitor

- The key competitors of the EU in the world market remain largely a closed also due to SPS problems
- But relevant import duties remain an obstacle for fry and frozen potatoes, particularly in the US. Next negotiating Round will take place on week of 29 September.
- **EU-Canada** negotiations expected to be wrapped up this month. Bilateral potatoes trade would be immediately liberalised upon entry into force (expected end 2016).



Conclusion

- The outlook for EU exporting industry is a positive one.
- As the EU market consumption stagnates, external trade will be the driver of future growth.
- EU active trade policy supportive of unlocking new markets, in particular across Asia and Latin America.
- These agreements also provide for a toolkit which can facilitate and speed up the solving of SPS-related problems.
